Please note all exhibitors need to enclose a copy of their pedigree for each exhibit not previously shown with ANCATS, prior to the closing date. This ensures all details are correct. All ANCATS shows are open style judging, you can watch your cat being judged.

JUDGING

Judging will commence at 9am sharp.

PAVILION

The 2023 ADVANCE™ Sydney Royal Cat Show will be held in Hall 3 - Pet Pavilion. The Pavilion will be open to the public from 9am to 7pm.

EXHIBITION OF CATS

Cages are provided at the show, these are cleaned and disinfected. Please do not use any disinfectants in the cages as it may react with the material of the cage, which is fibreglass. All Exhibitors must supply a base of towelling or cotton measuring 560mm x 510mm. Plain coloured bases are permitted. Items such as lace, ribbon, cord, food bowls or soft toys must not be left in cages. Any items that could become entangled will be removed by the Chief Steward.

All Exhibits must remain in the Pavilion until 5pm. Only the Owner, or their representative, may remove the Exhibit at the end of the day.

VETTING

Vetting will be conducted from 7am to 8.30am. No late vetting will be conducted.

AMENDMENT TO JUDGING TIMETABLE

ANCATS reserves the right to change the Judging timetable if necessary.

PARKING

Parking is not included with your ticket purchase. Parking must be purchased directly from Sydney Olympic Park Authority. The P5 car park is traditionally the car park that is used for parking at the show. This is the only car park that can be used for access to the showground if you are walking in with your cats.

We recommend that you book a spot early do avoid missing out.

EXHIBITOR CONFIRMATION ADVICE & DASHBOARD SLIPS

The Exhibit Confirmation Advice, otherwise known as a bench slip, indicates the Class in which your cat/s have been entered, and is required for access to the Showground. A Dashboard Slip will also be issued to Exhibitors with the Showtime Authorised Contact Person's mobile number printed on the slip. A Dashboard Slip must be displayed on the dashboard of each vehicle at all times while on the Showground.

EXHIBITOR PASSES

1 - 2 cats: Two (2) one-day entry pass
3 - 5 cats: Three (3) one-day entry passes.
More than 5 cats: Four (4) one-day entry passes.

Anthony Aldum - Cat Judges Guild of Africa WCF

I live in Cape Town South Africa with my wife Theresa and 3 children. I entered the Cat Fancy in 2000 showing 2 Persian kittens. A few years later I started showing and breeding Sphynx under the cattery name Exposed. Since then we have had several cats qualify for the SACC COTY and 2 Regional Winners at Cape Top Cat. I have owned and shown Domestics, Exotics, Siamese, British Shorthair, Sphynx and Lykoi.

In 2007 I began stewarding for WCF (World Cat Federation) and in 2009 I passed my entrance exam and qualified as a Pupil Judge with the WCF. In 2010

I wrote and passed my General and SOSH Judges Exam and qualified as an internationally recognized WCF judge for SOSH and have been judging at WCF, SACC & Independent clubs. In August 2014 I passed my final Category exams and was recognized as an internationally licensed All Breeds Judge with the WCF.

I am currently serving as the president of the Cat Judges Guild of Africa – An independent guild of Judges in Africa, as a service to the cat fancy and on several committees and clubs in the local cat fancy.

I have judged at WCF, SACC and independent Shows all over South Africa, as well as internationally with WCF at several shows in both India and China, as well as shows in Sweden and Thailand and independent clubs in Amsterdam, Germany and Dubai.

Dr Thea Lamprecht - Cat Judges Guild of Africa WCF

Thea qualified as a WCF All Breeds judge in June 2014. During her years of training, she trained at cat shows in Brazil, Czech Republic, Denmark, Dubai, France, Malta, Poland, Russia and Slovakia in WCF, FIFE, LOOF and Independent shows apart from exposure to cat shows in all the South African provinces where cat shows were held: Western Cape, Northern Cape, Eastern Cape, Gauteng and KwaZulu Natal. Thea was the first WCF qualified All Breeds judge in Africa and in South Africa. She also holds an Independent Judges license for CJGA and since 2015 she is a Cat Federation of South Africa (CFSA) guest judge.

She has judged internationally for WCF, LOOF, Independent and other cat federations in Belarus, France, Malta, Russia, The Netherlands, India, Australia (2015, 2018, 2019), New Zealand (2016), China, Thailand, Poland, Lithuania and Germany including several World Shows. She was invited to judge at the 2018, 2019 and 2022 CFSA Cat Of The Year shows. She had the honour to be on the judging panel for the SACC Cape Top Cat exhibition in September 2022.

Thea has been a member of the cat fancy in South Africa for more than 30 years and has been breeding different breeds of short haired cats for more than 3 decades together with her husband Johan. They bred 2000 SACC COTY female Cornish Rex LesBeauxChats Rexotic. After decades of breeding different breeds, they now focus on British Shorthair and Munchkins. Thea acted on the committee as membership secretary for the SACC All Breeds Cat Club (ABCC) for several years during the early 1990's, hosted a SACC Judges seminar at their home as well as did catering at ABCC shows and for many of their after show functions during the 1990's and early 2000's.

She has been involved with WCF and Independent cat show organising and administration since the inception of WCF and Independent cat clubs in South Africa and also with pupil judges training, examination and seminars. She was a Hills Science Diet Ambassador from 2015 to 2020 upon invitation. Thea has done and passed a feline and canine nutrition examination and regularly attends feline and canine nutrition and health workshops and symposia.

Thea completed her PhD in choral music education history in December 2021 from the University of Stellenbosch. She is research fellow at the Stellenbosch University music department and continues choral music history research and writing. She is married to Dr. Johan Lamprecht, President of CASA/ WCF in South Africa and past Second Vice President of the WCF board internationally. They live on a small holding in Durbanville, Western Cape, with their cats, chickens, Flemish giant bunnies and muscovy ducks. Thea enjoys cooking, gardening and oil painting as additional hobbies.

Daniel Germishuys - South Africa SACC

I have been involved in the Cat Fancy for more than a quarter of century in one way or another. I have started off as an exhibitor and slowly but surely progress to Runner, Steward and Awards Table.

I was asked to join a Club Committee and things start escalating from there – very soon I found myself with a portfolio of different positions on the committee and for years I have been a Show Manager and served in various other capacities on several committees.

Served on the Executive Committee first as Secretary, then as Show Administrator and later as Chairman of the Cat Judges Executive, Breed Council and also as Registrar.

In the interim I joined the Judges Course somewhere in the 90's and around seven plus years later qualified as an All Breeds Judge.

I am a member of the IJN, affiliated to the South African Cat Council.

I have been fortunate in being invited to judge not only in my own country but also in Germany, Austria, Italy, Australia, Malta, China, New Zealand and the USA.

I have owned and bred Siamese, Oriental, British, Persians and Exotics. I no longer breed but still have a British, Exotic and Devon Rex in my house along with a couple of dogs

Bambi Joy Edwards - ANCATS NSW WCF

I have been involved with the showing and breeding of cats since 1968 and have bred many Cats of the Year for the RAS and ANCATS and have won multiple Supreme Exhibits at Sydney Royal and Best in Shows in most Australia states.

I commenced judging in 1983 and I love it, and consider it a privilege to be given the opportunity by exhibitors around the world to handle their beautiful cats.

I have judged across Australia and the world. Apart from Australia the countries in which I have had the pleasure of judging include the UK, France, Belgium, Malaysia, USA, Japan, Dubai and NZ.

Bajimbi cats reside in countries around the world and have been foundational in many breeding programs notably the initial program of European Burmese in the USA.

An author of many articles for national publications and cat magazines I have appeared with my felines at seminars, shows and on national television, discussing many topics regarding responsible cat ownership and breeding.

Along with my husband Brian I was co founder of the Waratah State Cat Alliance in 1997, and proudly now ANCATS and have been involved in the running of the club ever since its inception.

I am thrilled to be judging at the ANCATS show at the Sydney Royal.
