The Show is open to the public from 9.00am each day and closes at 9pm. The Carnival stays open until later.

Exhibitors will have access to Sydney Showground via Gate 9 from 6am. Between 8.30pm and 10.30pm, only pass holders can enter Sydney Showground. From 10.30pm, the site is locked down.

Only pass holders with a valid Digital Photo ID Pass or other RAS accreditation will be admitted by security.
