

A PET IN A POT

Step 1



Find an old container you can turn into a bunny's face – an old Milo or coffee tin maybe, or a soup can...or an old pot or large jar.

Step 2



Paint the container whatever colour you want your bunny to be.

Step 3



Give your bunny a face – you can paint it on, or you could stick on eyes made from material scraps or use buttons. Don't forget to give him a fluffy nose – maybe a cotton ball? And two big teeth!

Step 4

Fill your bunny with soil or potting mix.

Step 5



Get a carrot and eat it... but leave the last 2 or 3cms of the carrot top. Make sure your carrot has some green still showing at the top – you don't want a snipped clean carrot.

Step 6



Put the carrot top half buried in the soil – make sure you can still see some of it – don't bury it completely.

Step 7

Water the carrot, and place it in the sun. Keep the soil moist over the coming days.

Step 8



Your bunny will slowly begin to develop new ears – a carrot won't grow but lovely lush green ears will appear.
